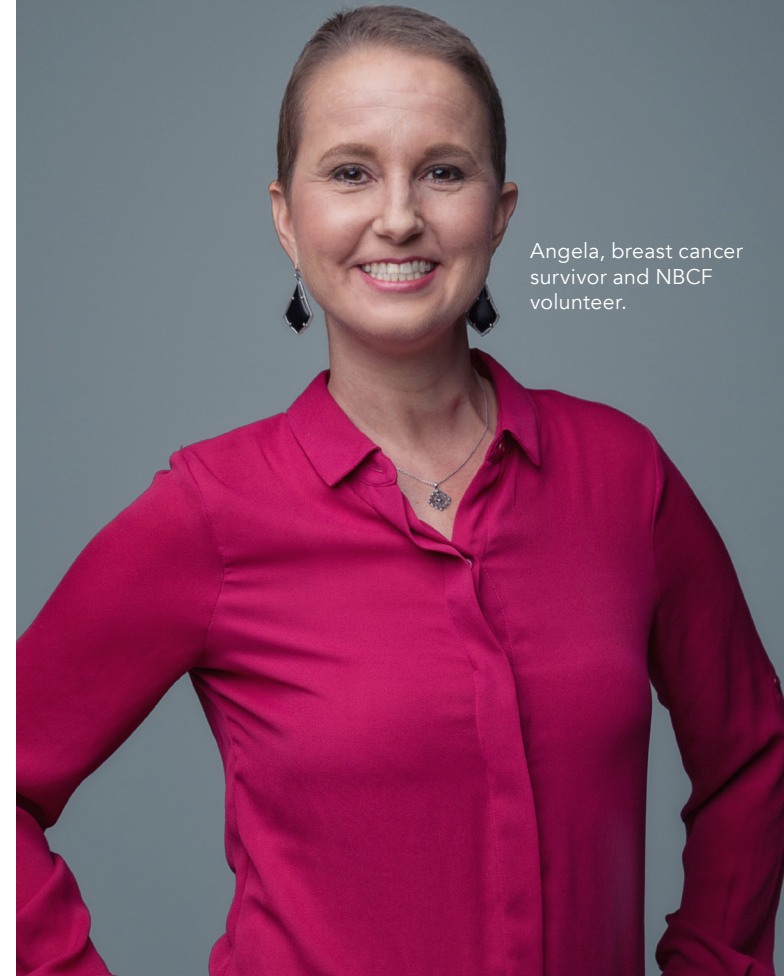

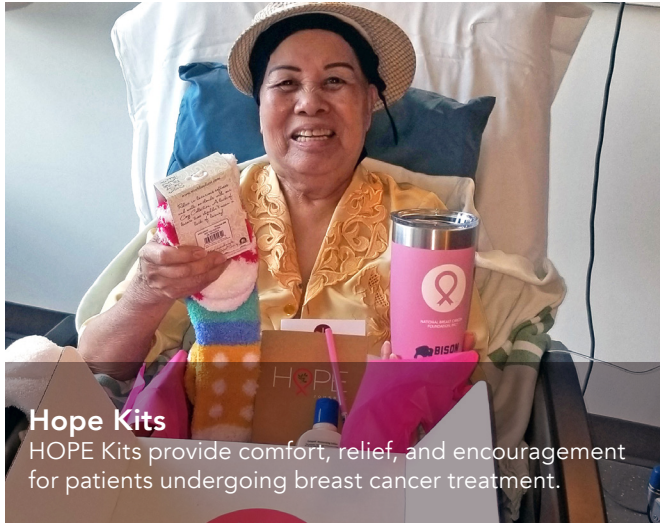

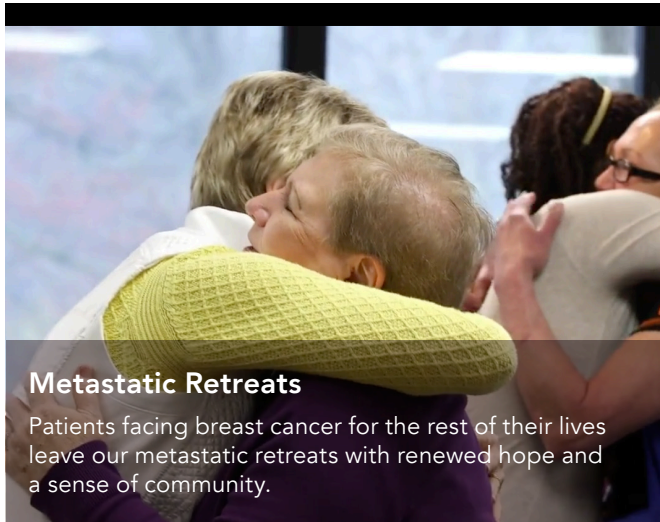
Hope Kits

Navigating Breast Cancer in the Workplace

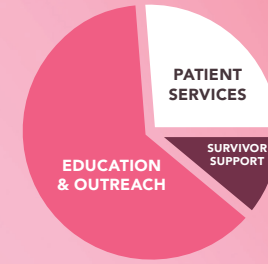
NBCF helps equip employers and employees with the resources and knowledge they need to accommodate their employees who are facing breast cancer.

Our patient navigators help patients overcome the barriers of cost, fear, and misinformation by helping underserved women to navigate the health care system.



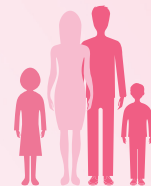
National Mammography Program
