NBCF was founded to fill in the gaps of cancer care, ensuring every woman has the information she needs to get through each step of her breast cancer journey. Our vision is that no one will navigate breast cancer alone.

Education and Outreach

We empower women to take control of their health by educating them about their bodies and providing important breast health resources.



Screening and Diagnostics

We provide free mammograms and diagnostic services for women in need through our partner facilities.

Patient Navigation Program

We provide patient navigation services through our partner facilities to help women navigate the complex cancer care system.



Support Services

We provide critical support for patients at every step-whether they're newly diagnosed, facing a terminal diagnosis, or facing breast cancer alone. Our goal is to ensure every patient and survivor has access to emotional support, guidance, and resources throughout their journey.

For over 33 years, NBCF has developed relationships with patients and their families affected by breast cancer by providing services for them along their breast cancer journey. Our multiple programs reach across healthcare barriers as we fund hospitals and medical facilities with navigator services to help underserved communities through mammography and diagnostic care. Our outreach includes workplace educational training, thousands of volunteers packing and distributing HOPE Kits to survivors, metastatic retreats for patients and their caregivers, and support groups in person and online.

One survivor attendee in our National Support Group powerfully stated, "It truly does help me to know others have walked my same path, but also that each one of our paths is unique in certain significant ways. I was able to see the beauty in the strength of the women in the group. We need not live in fear of the unknown any longer. United, we stand together as victorious."



National Mammography Program

NBCF has partnered with medical facilities^{*} in underserved communities across the U.S. by providing free breast cancer screening and diagnostic services. In 2023, NBCF partnered with 47 hospitals and provided 12,189 services.

There is currently no known cure for breast cancer, and its early diagnosis is critical to survival. When breast cancer is found in the earliest, localized stage, the 5-year relative survival rate is 99%.

Patient Navigation Program

This year NBCF partnered with 23 hospitals and provided 56,703 services to 30,732 women.

Breast Health Education

At NBCF outreach events, trained volunteers and staff review educational resources with underserved populations who face numerous barriers to accessing health services and adopting screening measures-from socioeconomic, linguistic, and cultural barriers to lack of knowledge. NBCF provides vital breast health education to those in need, empowering them to be more proactive about their breast health. Trained volunteers and staff review educational resources with guests and connect them with local medical facilities if they need access to screening and diagnostic exams.

IN 2023, NBCF DELIVERED

62 Breast Cancer Awareness in the Workplace presentations to 1,882 individuals. 8 outreach events hosted across the U.S. through Convoy of Hope, resulting in 2,988 women served.

Virtual navigation was offered via email and phone to 1,107 people, giving them critical information regarding breast health education, screening and diagnostic exams, financial assistance, and emotional support in both English and Spanish.



Metastatic Breast Cancer Retreats

In 2023, NBCF funded four retreats for 25 patients and 26 caregivers at Saint Luke's Cancer Institute, Kansas, and Johns Hopkins, Maryland.

Metastatic breast cancer retreats are a powerful way for NBCF to support women with Stage 4 metastatic breast cancer. Retreats focus on the metastatic diagnosis and prognosis, sharing of available resources, and emotional support of patients and caregivers so they can focus on fully enjoying life and time with their loved ones.



Support Groups

In 2023, NBCF hosted 35 monthly support groups attended by women across the country, with a total of 465 participants.

NBCF hosts monthly support groups where our group facilitator works with cancer survivors during "caring & sharing" time to encourage healthy dialogue and education for everyone involved. Having the support of others is an important part of breast cancer survivorship. Research shows that taking part in support groups, where you both give and receive help, is an effective way to reduce the stress and anxiety that can come with a breast cancer diagnosis.

In 2023, 6,185 individuals were served through this program by 61 trained ambassadors at 30 events. Over 81,910 print educational materials were distributed this year through Community Ambassadors and other community partners.

NBCF's Community Ambassador program trains and equips community leaders to share breast health information and promote NBCF's screening and navigation programs to those in need.


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
