- 1 in 8 women in the United States will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime.
- ✿ This year, an estimated 382,640 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in the United States.
- When diagnosed in an early, localized stage, the 5-year relative survival rate for breast cancer is over 99%.
- ✿ Approximately 66% of breast cancer cases are diagnosed at a localized stage*, when breast cancer is easier to treat.
- Women who receive regular mammograms have a 26% lower risk of dying from breast cancer compared with women who do not get screened.**
- ✿ Breast cancer is the most common cancer in American women, except for skin cancer. This year, approximately 30% of all new cancer diagnoses in women will be breast cancer.
- This year, an estimated 42,140 women will die from breast cancer in the United States.
- ✿ An estimated 2,670 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer this year in the United States. Approximately 530 men will die from breast cancer.
- There are over 4 million breast cancer survivors in the United States.

*Localized breast cancer is early-stage breast cancer in which there is no sign that the cancer has spread outside of the breast.
